NICHOLAS DE MOELS (Born 1200 o.e. Married HAWISE (as 2nd husband), dau. (younger) and co-heir of JAMES DE NENMARCH. By her, he (N. de M.) acquired lands in and around Somerset in or after 1230. HAWISE first married JOHN DE BOTREAU in 1218. He died after March 1229/30. N. de M. died by Easter 1271.)

ROGER DE MOELS (Son)
 (b. 1232 to son 1246, d. 17/6/1295 o.e.)
 In 1293 - Marshal of Army sent against Welsh.)

JOHN DE MOELS, 1ST LORD MOELS (b. 1269, d. 20/5/1310, m. MAUD ?) (Son)
 NICHOLAS DE MOELS, 2ND LORD MOELS. (b. 10/8/1289, d. 29/11/1315 - 16 o.e.)
 Married MARGARET DE COURTENAY before 1312/13, sister of HUGH DE COURTENAY, EARL OF DEVON. (No issue.)

JOHN DE MOELS, 3RD LORD MOELS (b. ?1304, d. 21.8.1337 o.e.) (Brother)
 (Married JOAN LOVEL, dau. of SIR RICHARD L. of Castle Cary)
 No male issue.

WM. BOTREAU = ISABEL DE MOELS (died 22.7.1349) (born 31.5.1326)
 dau. MURIEL DE MOELS married SIR THOMAS DE COURTENAY, bro. of HUGH DE C. (Earl of Devon) in 1337.
 WM, 1ST LD. BOTREAU = ELIZ. DAUBENY (d. 10.8.1391) (GEC) (born 1.9.1337) (bot GEC)
 She died 29.5.1433 (GEC)

JAMES DE MOELS died by 13/12/52-3.

RAYMOND DE CLYVEDON (I) = RAYMOND DE CLYVEDON (I) = (2) ELIZABETH AULE (d. 1280 o.e.)
 (In 1285, as widow, she held land in MILTON (100 of BLUTON, Som.) from ROGER DE MOELS.)

JOHN DE CLEVEDON (II), KNIGHT. (1303. Held ALGER as Lord. 1321. In Lancaster's rebellion by 1324. Back in K's favour.)

SIR JOHN DE CLEVEDON (III). (b. ?1295, bp. J's. seneschal in 1315, marr. by 1319 to MARY DE DIKOK, ? niece to bp. d. In 1322, he surrendered by gift to bp. d a life - hold in the MANOR OF WYVELISCAMPE at OKEHAMPTON. Died 1372 or later. ? Buried ALGER Church.)

SIR JOHN DE CLEVEDON (IV), KNIGHT. (Marr. ELIZ. ? d. by 1348.) (2nd wife) MARGARET DE CLEVEDON (d. 5/11/1411-12, bw. BATH ABBEY)

RAYMOND DE CLYVEDON (II). (b. before 1272. Attendant on ED. I. To Gascony with him in 1294.)

JOHN DE CLEVEDON (I). (1294. Of Somerset & Dorset, he served against Welsh. 1297. To serve in person beyond sea. By 1303. Dead. Marr. ELIZ. ? and had son JOHN (II). (Buried ? ALGER +))

SIR JOHN DE CLEVEDON (IV), KNIGHT. (Marr. ELIZ. ? d. by 1348.) (2nd wife) MARGARET DE CLEVEDON (d. 5/11/1411-12, bw. BATH ABBEY)

SIR JOHN DE ST. LO (KNIGHT, d. 8/11/1375) (had bro. ALEXANDER who was b. 1375.)

ELIZ. DE ST. LO (had bro. ALEXANDER who was b. 1375.)

WILLIAM, 3RD LORD BOTREAU (b. 20/2/1389-90, d. 16/5/1462, bw. N. CADRISURY)

His grandfather GODFREY was an illegit. son of RICHARD I, DUKE OF THE NORMANS (who was also the great-grandfather of WM. THE CONQUEROR).

French SEIGNEUR JOSSEIN DE COURTENAY.

(Great-grandson)

RENAUD DE COURTENAY = HAWISE, LADY OF OKEHAMPTON (d. 27/9/1194).

WILLIAM DE CURCY (alias GEOFFREY DE CRUNES/CRAON, dead 1162)

MARY, dau. of WM. DE REDVERS or DE VEKNON, 5TH EARL OF DEVON who mar. MARCEL DE BEAUMONT. (Their grandson BALDWIN was with K. HENRY III in GASCONY in 1242).

ROBERT DE COURTENAY (2nd. husb.) = MARY, dau. of WM. DE REDVERS or DE VEKNON, 5TH EARL OF DEVON who mar. MARCEL DE BEAUMONT. (Their grandson BALDWIN was with K. HENRY III in GASCONY in 1242).

JOHN DE COURTENAY = ISABEL (dau. of HUGH DE VERE, Earl of Oxford). (d. 3/5/1274).

HUGH DE COURTENAY, BARON OF OKEHAMPTON = LE DESPENSER. (d. 28/2/1291).

(Son)

HUGH DE COURTENAY, EARL OF DEVON, = (1292) AGNES DE ST. JOHN (d. 11/6/1340). (Sister of JOHN, Lord ST. JOHN OF BASING, who died 11/5/1329)

BALDWIN FITZGILBERT ("THE SHERIFF") OF MEULES, of SAL, of EXETER, of OKEHAMPTON, "de Molis" (d. 1090).

= EMMA (SISTER of WM. THE CONQUEROR).

WILLIAM D'AVLANCHES (1st husb.) = ?? of DOLTON (Devon). (d. about 1087).

ROBERT D'AVLANCHES = ??

MAUD D'AVLANCHES = MAUD D'AVLANCHES (d. 2/9/1173).

MARY's 1st. husband was PETER DE PRE(A)UX who held from K. JOHN TERSEY, GUERNSEY, ALDERNEY + 600 libras of land in ALTON, Hants. He was dead by 1213.

SIR JOHN DE ST. JOHN (KNIGHT).

(Dau.)

AGNES DE ST. JOHN (d. 11/6/1340).

(Sister of JOHN, Lord ST. JOHN OF BASING, who died 11/5/1329)
