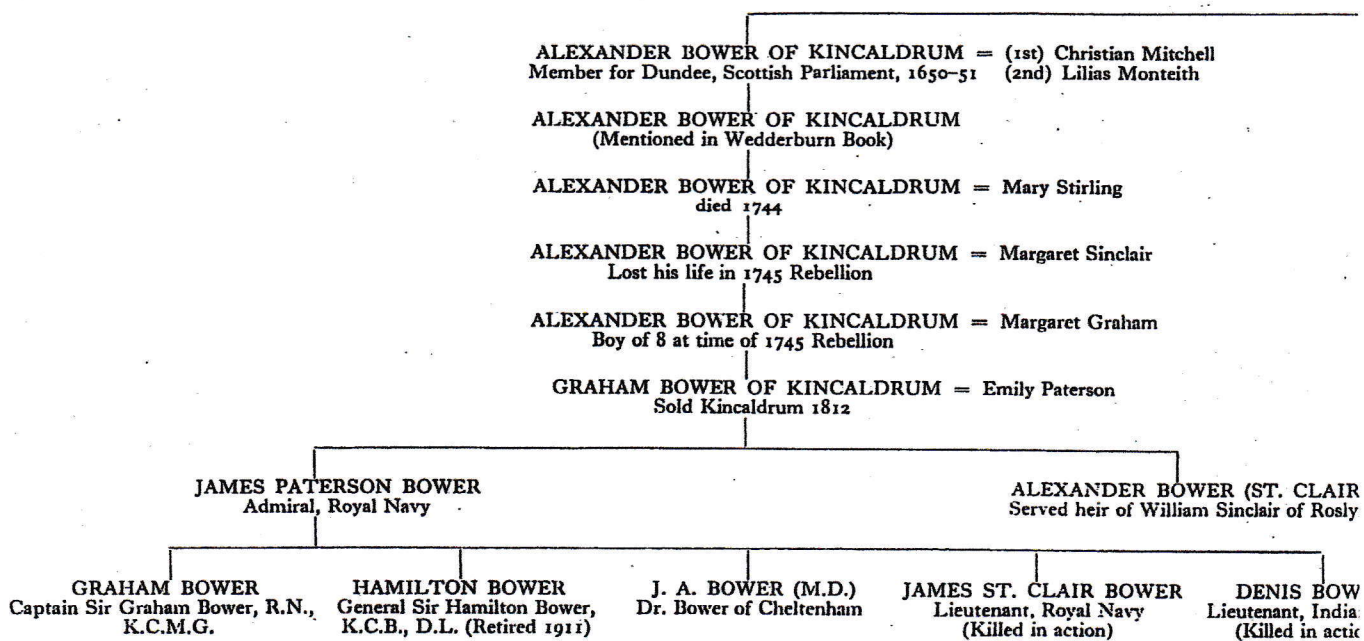
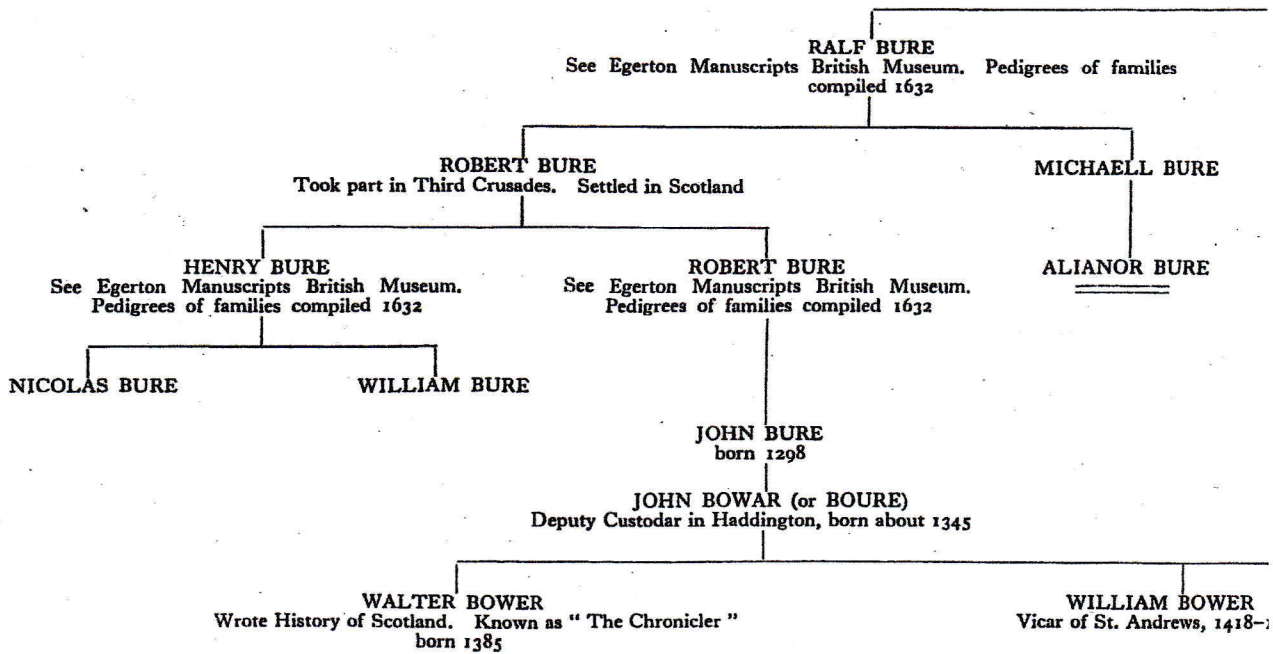


Studwell Bower family tree

in Somerset and one in Hertfordshire, as shown in the
The two Somerset Manors are now known as East Bower
near Bridgwater, Somerset, and are marked as such on the
present day Ordnance Map.

Held Dunbar Castle against James III

PATRICK BOWER
Held Dumbarton Castle against James IV

born 1482

THOMAS BOWER = Janet Coot
born 1541, died 1603

ROGER BOWER
Councillor Dundee Town Council 1606-1613

**ALEXANDER BOWER OF INVEREIGHTY = Margaret, daughter of Sir David Balfour
of Forset**
Inherited estates of Kincaldrum

**PATRICK BOWER OF KINNETTLES
AND WESTER MEATHIE = Christian or Catherine Duncan**
died 1685

**PATRICK BOWER OF KINNETTLES
AND WESTER MEATHIE**
died 1735

**WILLIAM BOWER OF KINNETTLES
AND WESTER MEATHIE = Mary Fraser**
Owner of Kinnettles at time of 1745 Rebellion

WILLIAM BOWER = Lucy Jane
Took part in 1745 Rebellion and escaped to England

WILLIAM BOWER = Susannah Sophie Bucke
born 9th April, 1781

EDWARD THOMAS BOWER = Hannah Taverner
born 10th October, 1824

ALFRED LOUIS BOWER = Dorcas Mona Blackett
born 8th October, 1858, married 14th April, 1901,
Dorcas Mona, Lady of Grace of St. John of
Jerusalem, youngest daughter of the late Captain
Edward Algernon Blackett, R.N., J.P., D.L.,
Northumberland and King's County, Ireland, of
Wylam, Northumberland (see Burke's Landed
Gentry also Plantagenet Roll of the Royal Blood
of England, Blacketts of Wylam). Lord Mayor
of London, 1924-25. Created a Baronet.
