The last verse of the hymn "Lead Kindly Light," was sung by Mrs. Jackson of Whitehaven; friends of Miss Bower, including all who, by their craftsmanship and assistance, built and furnished the shelter, so appropriate to the beautiful scenery in which it stands, were entertained to tea by Miss Bower at Strands Hotel. Mr. Whinerey voiced the thanks of her guests to their hostess.
